#### Addendum added 2/11/2013

Consider/Approve Staff Development Waiver and Reading/English Language Art; Mathematics; Science; and/or Social Studies Staff Development Wavier.

**Information**: Pursuant to TEC25.081, this waiver allow the district or charter school to conduct additional staff training for reading/English Language arts, mathematics, science, or social studies strategies aligned with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills in lieu of a maximum of two days of student instruction.

Pursuant to Texas Education Code (TEC) 25.081, this waiver allows the district or charter school to train staff on various educational strategies designed to improve student performance in lieu of a maximum of three days of student instruction. These are two separate waivers but can be made in one motion. Example: "I\_\_\_\_approve Staff Development Waiver and Reading/English Language Arts; Mathematics; Science; and/or Social Studies Staff Development wavier's.
