



Menard ISD has released our official “Back to School Survey” on the school website at [www.menardisd.net](http://www.menardisd.net). We need it completed by August 5<sup>th</sup> so we can get the data together for both sets of students. Please make sure you understand that home based learning or in class instruction is your choice as a parent or guardian. Each six weeks you can reevaluate your choice prior to the new six weeks starting.

The virtual home learning will be different than last year’s packets. The Texas Education Agency has put rules and guidance in place for us to create a plan. Your child will have to check in, watch teaching, participate in lessons, and turn in work **daily** for each subject. If your child does not engage daily, then they will be counted absent for that day. They will be graded on the work that they are doing, and it will not be pass/fail. High school course credit is determined by daily attendance in each class.

Menard ISD at this time will only allow participation in extracurricular if your child is attending in class instruction.
